

ISLAND RULES

Devil's Isle is for the use and enjoyment of members and their guests. Please read carefully!

- The assigned Harbormaster is in charge of docking procedures, collecting fees when hosting a visiting club, and maintaining good order. Please help make their job a pleasant one.
- Placement of boats is skippers' choice however, no boats over 35 ft. are allowed in the fingers to avoid excessive strain and physical damage to the docks.
- Members and guests should sign in on the Island Log whenever they visit. A regular member may invite one guest boat at a charge of \$25 per night. No guest boats on DI holiday weekends.
- Guests must always be accompanied by an active member. The sponsoring member shall be solely responsible for the guest's adherence to Island rules. Non-member groups visiting the Island must have prior approval from the Board of Directors, have paid the required fees, and be sponsored by an Island member who acts as Harbormaster during their visit.
- There is no docking charge for a member's second boats, i.e. run-about, ski-boat, dinghy, PWC, etc. However, a member's main cruising boat has space and location priority at the docks. Smaller boats may be docked inside the dock at the north end.
- Pets are welcome at the Island. However, please use the dog walk that runs into the interior of the Island to walk them. Please clean up after your dog. Dogs are required to be on a leash.
- Leave room for others to move safely around the Island. Please don't block the walkways or docks. Safety requires that members and guests refrain from running on the docks, decks, and walkways. This is especially important when the dinner bell rings.
- We take off the Island whatever we arrive with and leave no garbage behind. Fire burning is only for paper and debris from cuttings. Put out all fires before leaving the Island. Do not set off fireworks or shoot flare guns. They can start fires that will burn for a long time!!!
- Swim at your own risk. Weak swimmers should wear an approved PFD when swimming and stay close to the swim platform, as the current can be strong at times. Children under 10 are required to wear an approved PFD while swimming and at all times while on the walkways, decks and docks.
- Generator operating hours are from 8:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M. unless amended by the Island Chairperson, or the Cruise Director of the club or group who has paid for the use of the Island that weekend.
- **THE DISCHARGE OF UNTREATED HUMAN WASTE IS PROHIBITED!** ALL MEMBER'S BOATS AND GUEST BOATS are required to have, use and maintain approved marine heads and/or holding tanks/porta-potties while visiting the island.
- If you encounter trespassers just asking them to leave usually works. However, if a problem occurs and cannot be handled by you or other Island members contact the San Joaquin Sheriff at: 209-468-4400.
- At the request of the levee property owner and with agreement of the Board of Directors of Devil's Isle, No member or guest of the Island may use, in any way or for any purpose, the levee across the slough to the east of the Island.
